

In 2023 the city of Amersfoort celebrates the 75th birthday of our zoo DierenPark Amersfoort. Inspired by animals, you can come and see art this summer at Museum Flehite, Kunsthal KAdE and the Mondriaanhuis, Museum Flehite is hosting Art & Zoo, a family exhibition focusing on the relationship between people and animals. At Kunsthal KAdE, you can visit 'Wonderbaarlijke Wezens' and become acquainted with all sorts of extraordinary creatures roaming the earth. In the Mondriaanhuis Birds & Fish is on display, an exhibition in which contemporary artists and designers seek the essence of their subject through abstraction. A visit to the museum can easily be combined with a bicycle or walking tour through Amersfoort to admire some outdoor animal art. Here you can read all about it. Be surprised and get inspired this summer with a fun day out in Amersfoort.

ART & ZOO JULY 8 TO NOVEMBER 19




A family exhibition about our fascination with animals. Funny, touching and poignant stories from employees and visitors of the Amersfoort zoo, show how our view of animals has changed over the past 75 years. Their love and respect for nature is shared by the exhibiting artists. They explore the current fragile balance between humans and animals. For example, Florentijn Hofman made the meters high 'Pissende ijsbeer' for Museum Flehite, which refers to the changing climate and endangered habitat of the polar bears. Children can discover all kinds of things in a look-and-do booklet. And in Depot Junior they can make their own animal enclosure with clay and twigs and draw a badger or other animal as accurately as possible.



WALK OR BIKE ALONG THE ANIMAL ART OF AMERSFOORT!







Look closely and you can see that Amersfoort is teeming with works of animal art. Like the bull at the roundabout at Flierbeeksingel or the lion in Park Randenbroek, to name a few. 
WITHOOS EN VAN WITTEL PERMANENTLY ON VIEW



The work of the 17th century Amersfoort master painter Mathias Withoos once hanged side by side with the work of his pupil Caspar van Wittel. In Amerfoort Withoos taught Van Wittel the art of painting and cityscapes in particular. Van Wittel went to Italy and emerged as the founder of vedutism under the name Vanvitelli. Contemporary photographer and vedutist Hans Wilschut was inspired by Van Wittel and left for Naples. There he captured the Darsena in its full contemporary splendor from Van Wittel's point of view. The characteristic cloudscapes have remained unchanged throughout the centuries.



THE KOEKKOEK'S: FAMILY OF PAINTERS JULY 8 TO OCTOBER 1



The Koekkoek family of artists produced sixteen painters in four generations and is considered the largest family of painters in the world. Museum Flehite has a soft spot for Willem Koekkoek (1839-1895). He painted the Koppelpoort, a characteristic of Amersfoort. In Museum Flehite you will get to know the entire family through their paintings. Can you recognize everyone's special signature?

WONDERBAARLIJKE WEZENS UNTIL SEPTEMBER 3RD



For centuries, people showed interest in the extraordinary animals that roam the earth. This led to drawings, cabinets of curiosities, dioramas and zoos to observe these mysterious animals. In celebration of the 75th anniversary of the Amersfoort Zoo, Kunsthal KAdE features this exhibition raising questions like: In what ways can we create awareness for - and engagement with - animals? Where does wonder still exist? And what responsibilities do we as humans have towards animals? The exhibition features new and existing work by artists reflecting on the relationship between humans and animals. Artworks are also on display in the Amersfoort Zoo.

Kunsthal KAdE also invited artists to create new work for display in the zoo. These works challenge us to see things from a different perspective. Animals can interact with a few of the works. Like the giraffe in the picture with the work of Gijs Assmann. There are nine works in total on display at the zoo.



BIRDS & FISH UNTIL SEPTEMBER 17



The Mondriaanhuis selected contemporary artists and designers who sought the essence of their subject through abstraction. Like the Blocbirds by Paul & Albert. Birds are reduced to abstract graphic compositions, in which you can still recognize the bird. There is also work by Albert van Loon, an artist who explored the essence of a school of fish. Hélène Min used the real skin of fish for her abstract sculptures. In processing the wet fish skins, she experiences a direct contact with nature.





THE WORLD OF PIET MONDRIAN

PERMANENTLY ON VIEW

Discover all facets of the famous artist. Immerse yourself in his dynamic life and travel with Piet from Amersfoort to Winterswijk, from Amsterdam via Paris to London and finally to New York. You will learn how his work gradually changed from realistic landscapes to abstract compositions with the characteristic lines and planes. You can also get creative yourself in the DIY studio.
